### **Test Procedures**

### STEP 1: Writing your ID on the Sample Collection Tube label

 Using a ballpoint pen, write your name and date of sample collection on tube label.

### STEP 2: Make bowel movement onto collection paper

1. Take Collection Paper out of the envelope.


- 2. Peel off cover strip from the tape on each end of the paper.
- 3. Lift toilet seat. Spread paper across the bowl.




### STEP 3: Stool Sample Collection

1. Unscrew the Sampler Cap from the Sample Collection Tube. Do not spill or pour out the liquid.



- With the stool still on the Collection Paper, randomly poke the spiral end of the Sampler in at least 6 different sites of the stool. DO NOT SCOOP.
- Insert the Sampler back into the Sample Collection Tube and firmly tighten screw cap.
- 4. Shake the tube well to mix the stool and test solution.



5. Print your name and date on the vial.

### STEP 4: Mailing

- 1. Place collection tube in plastic bag.
- 2. Place plastic bag in mailing envelope.
- 3. Peel tape from envelope flap.
- 4. Fold flap on prefold line and press firmly.
- 5. Return to your doctor or laboratory.




